IF lifestyle limiting claudication AND failed primary care management (smoking cessation and exercise therapy) THEN please refer to vascular services via ESR. (ABPI NOT required prior to referral as ABPI will be undertaken in vascular clinic)

Patient asymptomatic (no claudication or critical limb ischemia) but needing ABPI to aid diagnosis of PAD

Patient has symptoms suggesting claudication/ lifestyle limiting claudication and ABPI needed to confirm diagnosis/commence primary care management/aid differential diagnosis

Patient has any wounds:

- If wound on leg/leg ulcers refer to LLWC at Crofton via SPOC
- Wound of foot/gangrene? Critical Limb Ischemia (arterial rest pain/ulceration) – REFER URGENTLY to vascular services via FSR
